

Dakota Adventist Camps Practices & Procedures | Summer 2020 Registration FAQ

How will registration be done this year?

- Registrations for 2020 camps are required to be completed online via the youth department website, <u>dakotayouthandyoungadults.org/camps</u>
- Online registrations will be the only accepted method of registering for 2020 camps.
- All campers must register for camp.
- There will be no allowance of campers who have not pre-registered.
- Any camper who shows up to camp and has not registered will be turned away.
- Payment must be made prior to any child attending camp.

What about camper scholarships?

 Scholarships will still be available to families in need. Contact your local pastor for any scholarships available through your local church, or Pastor's Ricky and Brooke Melendez via email, the youth department website, or at the conference office (701-751-6177) to make these arrangements.

When can I register my child for camp?

 Registration will open at 9am CT on Wednesday, May 27th, via dakotayouthandyoungadults.org/camps

How can I be sure my child will get a spot at camp?

- Registration will be first come, first served.
- Remember, there is a limited number of space available for 2020 camps. Our camps will be operating at 60% (Flag Mountain) and 65% (Northern Lights). When we reach that capacity, your child's name will be placed on a waitlist in the event that another child is unable to attend camp.
- Dakota kids will be prioritized during registration. Registration will be closed to residents of other states until May 31st, at which time it will be opened to residents of other states, permitting we have not reached the 60/65% capacity. Otherwise, names will be placed on the waitlist.

What if my child does not get a spot at camp or they are unable to attend due to any reason?

- We will be offering a live streaming option of the morning and evening worships at all camps.
 - If your child cannot attend because:
 - you are uncomfortable with them being at camp
 - they did not register in time
 - due to a medical condition that causes them to be "high risk"
 - they answered "yes" on the screening questionnaire
 - any other reason they may not be able to attend camp.....
 - We encourage them to participate virtually via the live stream!
